All Camps are designed to teach riders the responsibilities of owning a horse. In addition to presentations from industry professionals the campers will get hands on experience of feeding, cleaning stalls, grooming, bathing, and tacking up in preparation for riding. They will learn safety and

horsemanship, as well as riding/handling skills to become more effective horseman. Video analysis will also be used to help riders learn the basis of a balanced seat and how to more effectively communicate with their horse through the proper use of seat and leg aides.

Each camper will ride at least 1 hour per day, (Overnight Campers will ride and work with horses a minimum of 3 hours per day). They will develop their skills mounting, dismounting, starting, walking, trotting, turning, and stopping. As well as, gymnastics on horseback, crafts, trail riding, obstacle courses, jumping, and lunging/joining up, depending on the skill level of each rider. Individual goals will be set for all campers at the beginning of the session.

Overnight Campers may also get to participate in a field trip, as

well as a night ride with glow sticks.

All Campers will ride in a Freestyle Competition the last day of camp. Training throughout the week, will prepare them to choreograph a riding pattern with specific movements to music on horseback, (with a song of their choice).

Discussions and Exercises on practicing good horsemanship skills, the power in positive thinking and what determination can do, will provide invaluable "life skills" to your daughter/son.
